

Dress Policy

Students are expected to dress in a manner that is conducive to the atmosphere of a Catholic School, respecting the value of modesty. Modesty is the key consideration for parents and students concerning student dress.

As a guide, female students should not wear low-cut tops or tops that expose the abdominal area. Underwear and undergarment straps should not be exposed. The length of shorts, skirts and dresses should be closer to knees than to the hips.

Male students should have shorts and pants that cover underwear at all times. Tops without sleeves should not be worn.

For all students, no inappropriately suggestive or offensive slogans or pictures are to be worn. Hats, toques or hoods are not to be worn in the school.

Students dressed inappropriately will be required to change immediately. Detentions will be assigned to repeat offenders.
