Dear Grade 7 & 8 Parents,

Grade 7 & 8 students will be writing their final exams in the gymnasium on June 19, 22, 23 & 24th.

Students are expected to be at school in their Home Room when morning bells rings for announcements and to take attendance. The students will return textbooks and go to the Gym to be ready to begin Exams at 8:45 a.m. The time frame for writing exams shall be from **8:45 a.m. until 10:15 a.m.** However, if additional time is required students will be allowed to remain in the exam hall until 11:20 a.m. Students have a minimum required time for writing each exam. This will be explained to students at the beginning of each subject exam.

Study Hall:

A designated classroom will be used as a supervised study hall for those students who choose to stay or do not have permission to leave the school after the exams are completed.
