**Division Priority: SCHOOLS WILL PROVIDE QUALITY LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS**

### **School Strategy/Strategies:**

- Adapted a balanced timetable to better accommodate student learning
- Increased health and wellness breaks for both students and staff
- Movement toward true middle school philosophy – implementing program and staffing specialization
- One to One Technology Project - supporting and enhancing technology integration into the classroom
- Language Arts and Mathematics will be an instructional priority. Continue with prioritize literacy and numeracy through the Language Arts and Mathematics program
- Develop lessons for students as recommended in the First Steps reading resource.
- Continue assigning levelled books to students from the school library collection and classroom collections.
- Provide opportunities for students to use Read & Write for Google and Lexia to enhance literacy.
- Daily embedded literacy time with a focus on individual reading (Designated time to begin each afternoon in homeroom environment)
- Use Fountas & Pinnell support systems to assess reading levels of all students in grade five and six and to assess the reading levels of grade seven and eight students that are struggling with reading.
- All staff will commit to using the Collaborative Response Dashboard in PowerSchool to record Fountas & Pinnell reading levels
- Provide teachers with Collaborative Response Model CRM time to share best practises and develop common long-range plans and unit plans
- Use EICS Pyramids of Support document to guide our dialogue in Collaborative Response Model time and learning team meetings
- Staff will commit to using PowerSchool to record dialogue and communicate action plans
- Use “PATs”, “Insight” and “CAT4” assessment results to guide individual and class teaching and planning.
- Provide collaboration time among the three schools in Fort Saskatchewan to build a scope and sequence plan - K - 4, Gr. 5 - 8, Gr. 9 - 12
- Develop and Implement more transition strategies for students moving from gr. 4 to gr. 5
