

## **Dress Code Policy**

Students are expected to dress in a manner that is conducive to the atmosphere of a Catholic school, respecting the value of modesty. Modesty is the key consideration for parents and students concerning student dress code.

As a guide, students' midriffs, stomachs, buttocks and cleavage must be completely covered. Underwear and undergarment straps should not be exposed. Students should have pants or shorts that cover underwear at all times.

No inappropriately suggestive or offensive slogans or pictures are to be worn. Shoes must be worn at all times. Hats, toques or hoods are not to be worn in school.

**Students whose dress does not meet our dress code regulations will be asked to change into appropriate wear.**
